Getting the Most Out of Luke

This study of Luke is designed for the individual as well as the small group. You as an individual or a small group can be as flexible in your study of this series as you would like. As you begin this study please *pray that God will speak to you through his Word.*

THE FIVE STUDY SERIES:

Responses to Jesus, a five week study beginning Monday, September 14 – Sunday, October 18, 2009. * **(All Church Study)**

Instructions for Disciples, a six week study beginning Monday, October 19 – Sunday, November 29, 2009

Following Jesus, an eight week study beginning Monday, December 21 – Sunday, February 14, 2010.

The Week That Changed The World, a five week study beginning Monday, February 15 – Sunday, March 21, 2010. * **(All Church Study)**

The Risen Lord, a two week study beginning Monday, April 5 – Sunday, April 18, 2010.

THE RESOURCE:

The book, "Luke for Everyone" by N. T. Wright will serve as the resource for our study. It contains scripture, commentary, and a glossary.

* *There will be two All Church Studies throughout this series.*

THE STUDY QUESTIONS:

During the **All Church Study**, the Pastors will develop study questions to accompany the sermons and enhance the commentary by N.T.Wright. These questions along with three core application questions will serve as the discussion starters for this study.

The Three Core Application Questions Are:

How is God changing your life? (This is an opener to be used weekly.)

What is your next step in following Jesus? (This could come through discoveries or realizations you had because of this study.)

Who can you help take the next step in following Jesus? (This could come through God's invitation to you through this study.)

The small group questions will be emailed to everyone the Monday prior to the sermon.

WAYS TO PARTICIPATE:

If you are an existing small group:

You can study the gospel of Luke for the whole year. During our two All Church Studies, the Pastors will provide questions for your group to discuss. It is recommended that the group meets on a weekly basis for the **All Church Study**, *Responses to Jesus*. (Example, The study questions will be emailed on Monday, September 14th. The sermon will be on September 19th and 20th. The group should plan on meeting the following week, September 21st.) The rest of the time you can discuss the scriptures using *Luke for Everyone* and the sermons as a guide.
