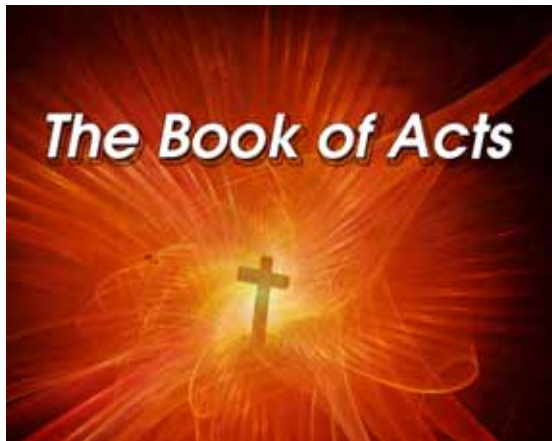

IMAGINE UPDATE

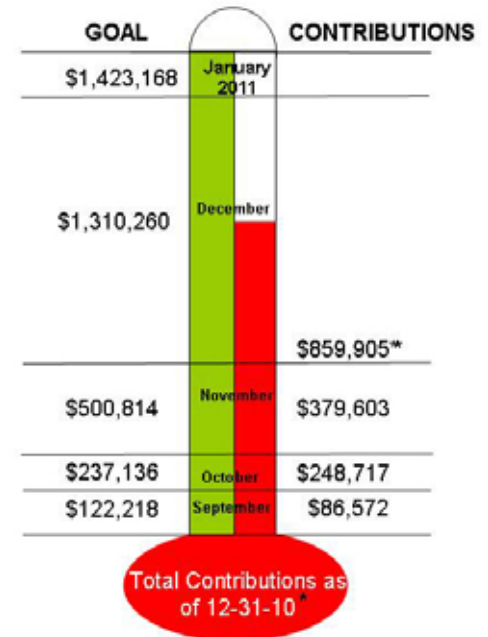
Read the upcoming February Alive IMAGINE and Missions articles to see how your IMAGINE contributions are bringing the love of Christ to those most in need.
