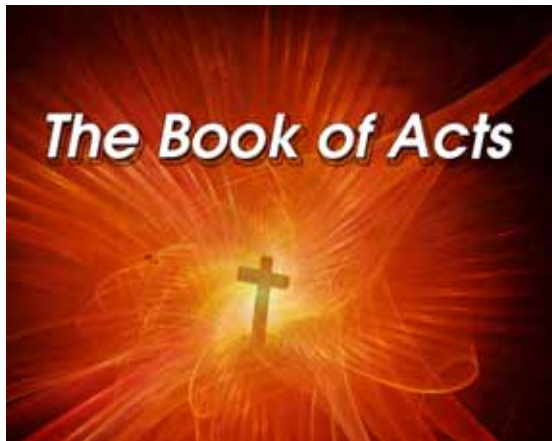

TERMS OF DISMISSAL CONTRIBUTION
