SRVCA KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT

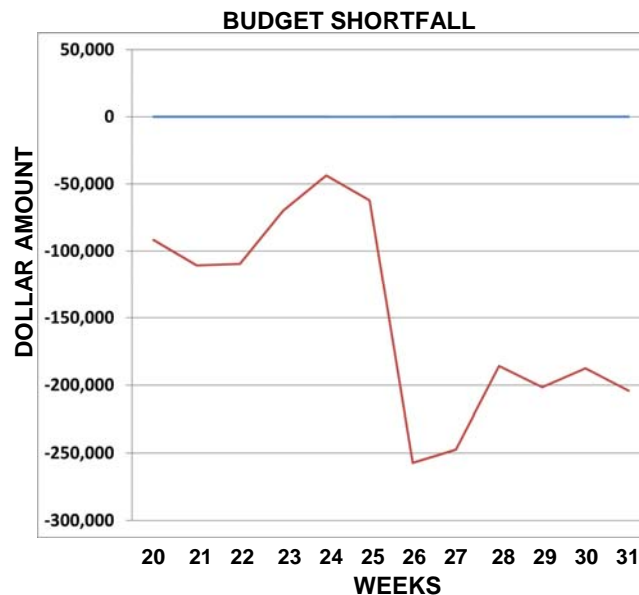
