1 Samuel 1: 10-28

"The LORD had closed her womb" [v. 6]

"and the LORD remembered her. So in the course of time Hannah conceived and gave birth to a son. She named him Samuel saying, 'because I asked the LORD for him.'" [vv. 19-20]

"You created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb . . ." [Psalm 139]

"Children are a gift from the Lord" [Psalm 127:3]

SERMON NOTES

"I am a woman who is deeply troubled . . . I was pouring out my soul to the LORD . . . I have been praying here out of my great anguish and grief." [vv. 15-16]

"I prayed for this child, and the LORD has granted me what I asked of Him." [v. 27]

SERMON NOTES

“After he was weaned, she took the boy with her, young as he was, along with a three-year-old bull, and ephah of flour and a skin of wine, and brought him to the house of the Lord at Shiloh. When they had slaughtered the bull, they brought the boy to Eli...” [vv. 24-25]

“You brought me out of the womb; you made me trust you even at my mother’s breast. From birth I was cast upon you; from my mother’s womb you have been my God.” [Psalm 22:9-10]

SERMON NOTES

“Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has born? Though she may forget, I will not forget you! See, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands.” [Isaiah 49:15-16]

“So now I give him to the LORD. For his whole life he will be given over to the LORD.” [v. 28]
