

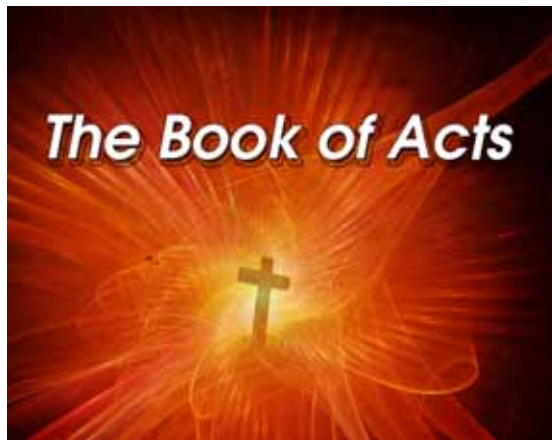

## SMALL GROUP SIGN-UPS

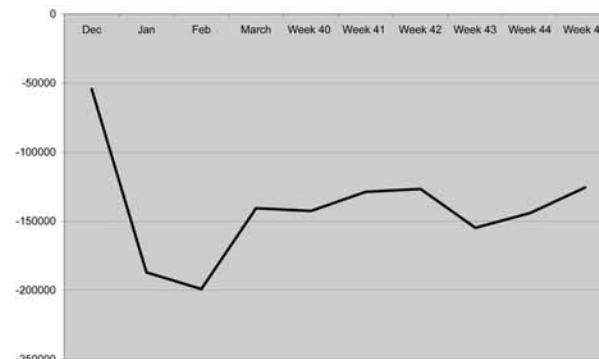
