

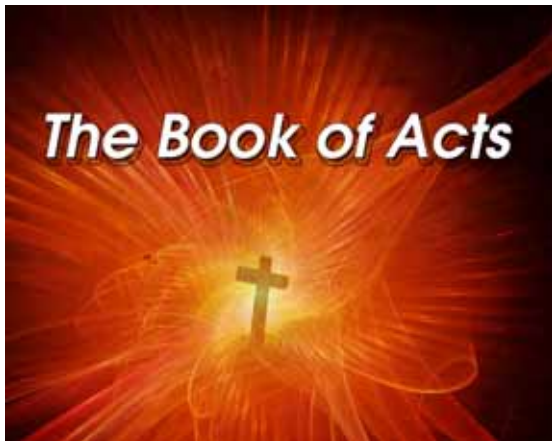

#### JOB CONNECTIONS CAREER & LEADERSHIP SUMMIT-SATURDAY, JUNE 4

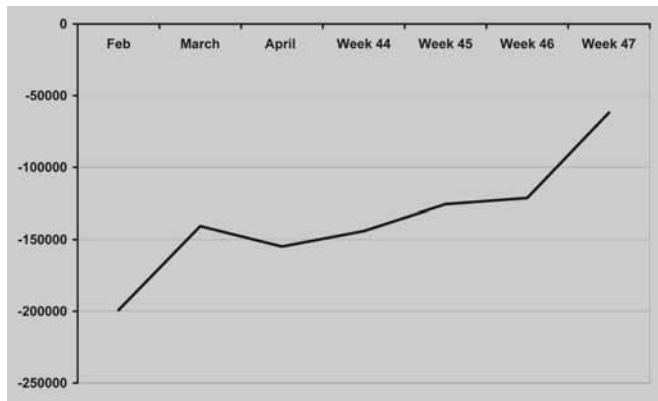
