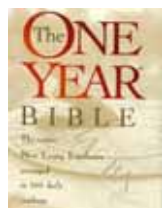

ONE YEAR BIBLE SUMMER SERIES

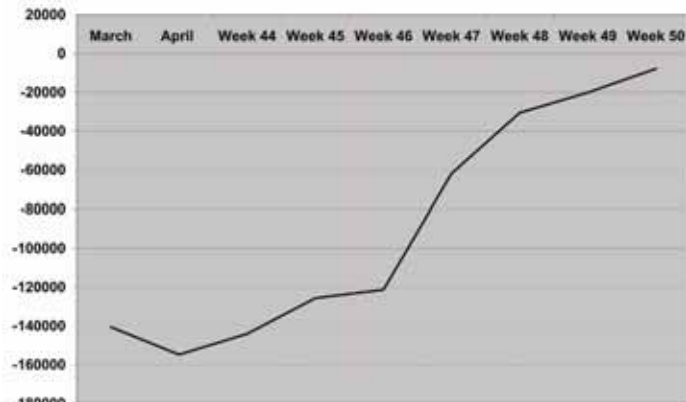
