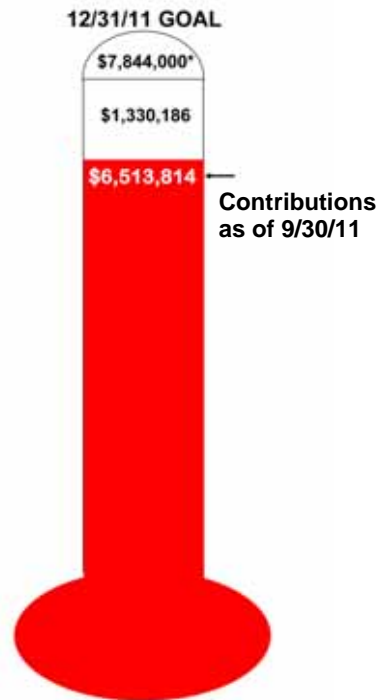
IMAGINE
