“The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into the harvest field.” [v.2]

“After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go.” [v. 1]

“He told them, ‘The harvest is plentiful, but he workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.’” [v. 2]

“Go! I am sending you out like lambs among the wolves. Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road.” [Vv. 3-4]

“When you enter a house, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’” [v. 5]

PRAY for them.

“If a man of peace is there, your peace will rest on him; if not, it will return to you.” [v. 6]

“Stay in that house, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house. When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is set before you.” [Vv. 7-8]

STAY with them.

“Heal the sick who are there and tell them, ‘The kingdom of God is near you.’” [v. 9]
