COUPLES TOGETHER BEGINS JANUARY 15

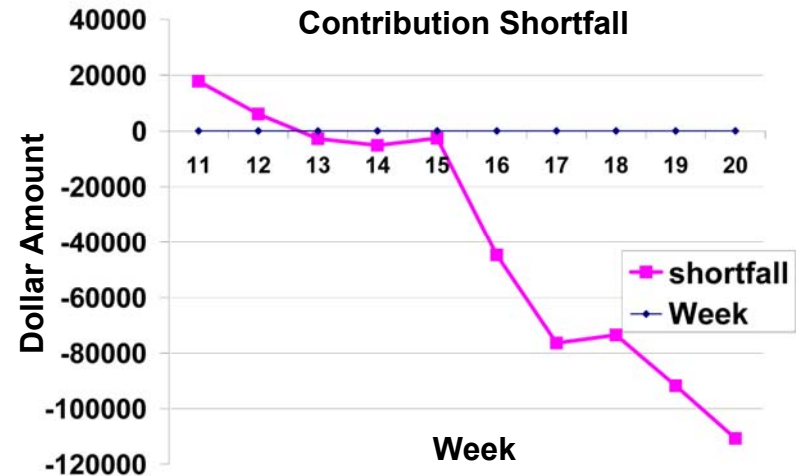
