8. What does the resurrection of Jesus mean to you personally? How does the resurrection change our understanding of God's plans and ways compared to our expectations?
9. How does the story of Jesus pursuing Peter after his denials demonstrate God's love and grace? In what ways have you experienced God's pursuit and restoration in your own life?
10. How does the message of Easter inspire hope, joy, and a fresh start in your life?
