DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How does the concept of leaving a legacy resonate with you personally?
- 2. What stood out to you from the previous LEGACY sermons—the BIG vision? The potential for generational impact?
- 3. Why do you think money is such a taboo topic in many churches? How do you view wealth in light of the statistics shared about average household income?
- 4. Discuss the significance of the Bible's emphasis on money and its relationship with our hearts. What do YOU think is the most significant benefit to giving/being generous?
- 5. **Read 1 Chronicles 29:14, and Deuteronomy 8:17-18**. How do these passages challenge our understanding of wealth and success? Why/how do people struggle to believe that everything they have is a gift from God?
- 6. **Read Genesis 4:2-7**. Reflect on the story of Cain and Abel. What does it mean to give God our "first and best"? Why is that such a struggle for so many?
- 7. Share a personal experience where generosity brought happiness or blessings to your life. How does generosity help us resist the sin of greed and align our hearts with God's will?
- 8. **Read 2 Corinthians 9:11 and 13**. What is a defining moment for you that transformed your life? How were others involved in that moment? How does your generosity help make such moments possible for others in the future?
- 9. Think about the people who have impacted your faith journey. How have their prayers, teachings, and sacrifices shaped your life? How does recognizing our blessings and the sacrifices of others inspire us to live generously?

Share prayer requests with each other and pray for one another. Perhaps pray Psalm 139:23-24 out loud...then spend a few moments in prayer, asking God to search your heart and guide you in how to honor Him with your resources.
