### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What stood out to you from today's message about wrestling with God and responding in faith?
2. **Read Genesis 32:22-31.** Reflecting on the story of Jacob wrestling with God, what parallels do you see in your own life?
3. The sermon emphasizes the importance of “quiet persistence” in wrestling with God. How can you create space for the quiet persistence (ie practical steps) required to wrestle with God in your own life ?
4. Jacob's identity was transformed through his encounter with God. How does this concept of renewed identity apply to us today? Why/where are we tempted to find/base our identity in things other than God?
5. The sermon also mentions making sacrificial gifts based on faith rather than solely on calculations. How do you discern what it means to give sacrificially in your own life?
6. How can the concept of wrestling with God and responding in faith impact the way you approach challenges or decisions in your life?
7. Share a personal experience where you felt like you were wrestling with God. How did you respond, and what were the outcomes?
8. Reflect on the notion of blessing and transformation that comes from wrestling with God. In what areas of your life do you seek blessing and transformation?
9. Lastly, consider “Commitment Sunday” for the Legacy Campaign. How do you feel called to participate, and what steps can you take to contribute to the campaign in a meaningful way?
